




The UK education system

In the UK, students normally take A levels before starting their Bachelors (or undergraduate) degree, which usually lasts three or four years. Our Foundation Certificate courses are also a recognised qualification for entry to a Bachelors degree, and are specially designed for international students.

Some university graduates then study for a Masters (or postgraduate) degree, which usually lasts one year. Our Pre-Masters courses bridge the gap between your existing university credit and the level needed for entry to a postgraduate degree.


