
If you study in Uxbridge and wish to live there rather than High Wycombe, we have an established partnership with a local student-friendly estate agent who offers a good selection of student properties.



How did we achieve our number one ranking? Well, regardless of what you're into, you're sure to find something that interests you. There are societies that satisfy the most eclectic hobbies, sports teams to fuel the competitive soul, and activities to cure any bout of boredom. Joining our Students' Union doesn't cost a thing, as you'll automatically become a member when you enrol on a course. Combined with the Big Deal, we're sure you'll have a student experience like no other.


Reading Rockets Basketball

Enrolment


All students need to formally enrol onto their course. You can help by making sure they complete this, and all the information you need can be found by visiting bucks.ac.uk/welcome.

Apprenticeships

Higher and degree apprenticeships have seen a huge growth in the last few years as they're a flexible alternative to studying full-time – where you can get a university qualification and work as an apprentice with an employer at the same time. We're now working with a variety of organisations to offer apprenticeships in everything from nursing to business.

When you join an apprenticeship programme you'll study alongside your day job, accessing relevant training to help with your career, and gaining a higher or degree-level qualification.

It's an appealing route, particularly if you like the idea of on-the-job training. Higher and degree apprenticeships are funded by your employer and the Government, and you earn a salary the whole time you're training.

If you're not in full-time work, or not working for a company that can fund and support your degree apprenticeship, you'll need to apply for a higher or degree apprenticeship with a company that offers them. You'll follow their standard recruitment process and the training provider will assess your academic suitability for the course.

BA

A BA is also known as a Bachelor of Arts. These undergraduate degrees are usually associated with humanities and the arts.

BSc

A BSc is also known as a Bachelor of Science, and is an undergraduate degree in a science-related academic field.

Foundation Degrees (FDA/FDSc)

These are intermediate work-related courses in arts or sciences, and usually studied over two academic years. On successful completion of a Foundation Degree you usually have the opportunity to top up to a related BA or BSc degree.

Degree Apprenticeships

A degree apprenticeship combines full-time paid work and part-time university study to offer you the opportunity to gain a full Bachelors or Master's degree while partaking in practical, on-the-job training.

Foundation Year

If you don't quite meet the entry requirements to get onto your dream course, a Foundation Year could be for you. With an additional year, it allows you to develop your academic study skills, and build confidence in your abilities.

LLB

An LLB is Latin for Legum Baccalaureus (Bachelor of Laws) and is the undergraduate degree for all law and law-related courses.


Strong industry links



Policing is changing. The police service needs to recruit both police officers and non-warranted police staff from all communities to undertake challenging front line roles.

Policing



If you are considering a career within the police service, as either a police officer or police staff, or even a role within the broader criminal justice and security environment, we can add real value to your chosen career path.

Our undergraduate policing programmes will support you in developing your skills, knowledge and understanding. We have worked in partnership with Thames Valley Police in delivering policing programmes for over 15 years.

We actively encourage our students to become special constables within Thames Valley Police or to undertake another voluntary role within the community. Whilst this is not an essential requirement, it does provide a great opportunity to gain real operational experience, enhancing key competencies related to employability.

Our BSc (Hons) Police Studies with Criminal Investigation programme is aimed at those who are considering a career as either a police officer or police staff, or a career in the broader criminal justice and security environment. This degree will help you to take an informed decision about your future career destination and takes a broader examination of policing and related activities rather than a specific focus on preparing you for a career as a police officer.

Applicants should be aware that from 2020, graduates who complete this degree and successfully apply to become police constables will have to undertake a graduate conversion programme during their initial police officer training.

If you don't quite meet our entry requirements, then our optional foundation level year for this programme is a great way to develop the skills you need to complete this degree.

Our approach

Our teaching staff includes professionally qualified former police officers and police staff. Our students learn the importance of effective communication and professionalism, the layered complexities of communities, the law, police discretion, and ethical conduct. Our policing students graduate as creative thinkers and problem solvers.

Our programmes are geared towards employability and are operationally focused. We have excellent links to serving police officers and staff, who

are invited to make presentations to our students. We help our students prepare for their future careers, developing their academic writing, research and study skills, and offering advice from our careers team.



Absolutely fascinating. That’s how we’d describe psychology. Through theory and research, it unravels an enormous range of complex challenges to explain behaviour and how our brains work.

With input from industry employers, we’ve designed seven psychology courses to help you develop the skills you need for an array of exciting careers in the public, private and voluntary sector.

At Bucks, our experts know how to bring the subject alive. You’ll see why we’re 10th in the UK for making the subject interesting and 15th for challenging our students to achieve their best work (National Student Survey 2018).

Our department is home to a buzzing community of psychology and social science students. So you’ll join forces on some projects and always have plenty of volunteers when you run your own experiments in our labs!

Learning in the lab

Think you’ll always be in the lecture theatre? Think again. As well as listening to our experts, you’ll join smaller groups in labs and seminars to discuss different areas.

At the same time as exploring theory, you’ll learn to analyse data. We’ll help you master SPSS, the statistics software social scientists use to analyse and present data.

You’ll also spend time in our observation laboratory using specialist equipment such as Biopac© to measure different physiological responses, Tobii eye tracking equipment and HTC Vive, and virtual reality software.

To give you insights into different areas, we also arrange trips to places like prisons and courts. You’ll see psychology in action and see how your knowledge can be used in the real world.

When it’s time to concentrate on completing assessments, our library is the perfect place to find the resources you need and quiet place to study. Or, if you’d rather work off campus, e-Journals and resources are only a few clicks away using our Virtual Learning Environment.

Your psychology career

Whether you just want to look at the subject as a whole or specialise in a particular area, we have a course for you at Bucks. You can use our degrees as a launchpad into a variety of careers in the field.





You don't even need to have studied psychology before. We've designed courses that help you get up to speed with the theory behind the subject and the latest thinking in the field.

Most of our courses are also professionally accredited, approved and regulated by professional bodies. This includes the British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP), the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC).

All our psychology degrees are also accredited by the British Psychological Society (BPS), the representative body for psychology and psychologists in the UK.

After you finish your degree, you'll be eligible for the Graduate Basis for Chartered Membership of the BPS (if you achieve a 2:2 or higher). This is the first step towards becoming a chartered psychologist.

Which course?

Our Behavioural Science degree focuses on human behaviour and emotion. You'll cover cognitive, biological, developmental, social and personality psychology.

As you progress through this highly flexible course, you'll also have the chance to tailor your degree and your study towards your interests. You can choose from optional modules like applied sport and performance psychology, and gender and sexuality in society.

Alternatively, you might be motivated to explore criminal minds. Pick from our Psychology and Criminology or Criminological Psychology degree. Both courses focus on forensic psychology, victimology and psychology in the criminal justice system.

Typically graduates from these courses work with offenders. They're employed by the civil service, local government, probation service, and more.

Or, perhaps you already know that you want a career in counselling? Our Counselling Psychology is an idea stepping stone to a future in clinical psychology.

Security and Resilience

You can explore opportunities to work with governments to analyse intelligence and identify national security risks. Or you can move into the business


world. Companies large and small need specialists who can see the risks and help minimise them.

Frequently asked questions

You may have a number of questions or worries. We hope that these pages help to answer most of them.

What qualifications do I need for a degree programme?

You'll find the UCAS Tariff score requirements for each course on the individual course pages on our website.

Very few of our courses require subject specific qualifications or experience, although, as some do, you should check the course entry requirements before you apply.

For some courses, you'll have an interview. If you need an interview, you'll be informed by email, or through UCAS Track, of the time, date and location. Whether you can attend, or need to reschedule, you'll need to respond as soon as you get the invitation, as interview dates are limited. For further details visit bucks.ac.uk.

What do I need for a full-time foundation degree programme?

You'll find the UCAS Tariff score, as well as the Maths and English Language requirements, for each course on the individual course web pages.

How will my application be assessed?

Each application is assessed on its individual merits. We accept a wide range of qualifications from a diverse selection of applicants.

What if I'm a mature applicant?

This applies to anyone over the age of 21 and your application is more than welcome. Age is no barrier and can be an advantage in terms of work skills, motivation and life experience.

Even if you don't have any A-levels but are looking to develop yourself, to progress in the workplace, or are unemployed and looking for a new start, we'd still like to hear from you.

We will look at your relevant work experience, so make sure you specify this in your personal statement.

Can I transfer to Bucks from another university?

We will help you in any way we can. You may even gain an exemption from any parts of the course you've already studied under the Credit Accumulation and Transfer Scheme (CATS).

We will look at your case individually. The best thing is to discuss it with us in more detail, giving details of the courses you've taken at other institutions and the exams you passed there. We will request copies of your transcripts (if you have completed your course) and a copy of your student handbook, which describes the content of each module.



What if I have a disability?

Help us to give you the right support, by declaring any dyslexia, mental health difficulties, medical conditions or other disabilities. We will assess your individual needs and the support we can provide for you during your time at Bucks. We can also discuss making reasonable adjustments to allow you to undertake your chosen course, and we'll help you decide whether the course you have selected is the best choice for you.

What if I've been in care?

We recognise that those leaving care face a number of significant challenges when considering higher education. Bucks is proud to have been awarded the Buttle UK Quality Mark in recognition of our support for care leavers. We have an admissions team who can give you advice on interviews, portfolios, auditions and personal statements. The team can

also talk to our accommodation staff on your behalf, highlight scholarships and bursaries for which you might be eligible, or put you in contact with our dedicated careers advice team who can offer pre-entry careers support should you require it.

What if I have a criminal conviction?

Make sure that you declare any criminal convictions in your application where possible because failure to do so may result in your application being withdrawn. If you are not able to give us notice of this, you may be asked the question upon enrolment.

Having a criminal conviction will not always prevent you from studying at degree level. Some professions are stricter than others, which is why we request further information from you to make sure you can progress in your chosen field.

How do I track the progress of my application?

Any decision we make will be uploaded onto UCAS Track or sent by email. If your application has been submitted through UCAS, they will then contact you, via your chosen method, to advise you to log onto Track to view the changes. As well as seeing decisions on Track, this is where you also reply regarding any interviews or offers you've been made.

How to apply

For full-time undergraduate courses, you need to apply through the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS). You'll find full instructions at ucas.com.

UCAS has a range of comprehensive guidance notes to help you through every step of the process. When you fill in your UCAS form, make sure you quote our UCAS institution name and code: **BUCKS B94**.

Also, remember to complete your personal statement with your application as best you can – it really is your opportunity to sell yourself. Along with this, you'll need one valid current reference for the majority of courses, although some do require two. Above all, make sure your application is fully completed before you submit it to UCAS. An incomplete application may not be accepted.

Please ensure that you carefully adhere to all additional UCAS deadlines with regards to replying back to your decisions so that you do not lose any offers made to you.

What qualifications do you need?

The UCAS Tariff table on page 102 is a guide to how many UCAS points your qualifications equate to. We base all our undergraduate full-time offers on the UCAS Tariff table and our course information includes the preferred amount of points we require.

Depending on your circumstances however, you may be made an offer that's higher or lower than this typical offer.

We also accept a variety of European and international qualifications, providing that they are equivalent to our entry requirements. More information

is available regarding individual country equivalents at bucks.ac.uk. In addition to this, we require GCSE Maths and English Language qualifications at grade C or above (or equivalent qualifications such as Functional Skills Level 2) for some of our subjects.

Our admissions policy

We welcome applications from prospective students from all backgrounds, and will consider applications on a fair and equal basis. We're committed to widening access for all those who can benefit from higher education and to widening participation from under-represented groups. What happens after I apply?

You'll be sent a postcard to acknowledge receipt of your application. This will also contain contact details, just in case you need to get in touch.

Next, we'll check your application to make sure it's fully completed and that you meet the entry requirements. If we need any further information, such as copies of your passport or qualifications, we'll email you with details of everything we need to process your application.

Once we have all the required information, we'll make a decision on your application, which will be shown on UCAS Track.

This could be:

- **Asking you to attend an interview:** the date and time will appear on Track and we'll email you with any additional details. You must reply to confirm your attendance.
- **Conditional offer:** this offer is made if you're currently completing your qualifications. The conditions will be visible on Track if you click into the offer.
- **Unconditional offer:** this offer is made if you've met all the entry requirements.
- **Rejection:** if your application is not suitable, we will contact you to discuss your options. The reason will be shown on Track.

Applicant Visit Days

Unconditional Offer Scheme

The Bucks New University Unconditional Offer Scheme has been created to identify undergraduate applicants, in certain subject areas, who we think would excel at Bucks and make a significant contribution to our learning community. Selection is based on a combination of contextual factors including: academic grade predictions; interview/portfolio/audition performance; prior examination performance (such as GCSEs); widening participation criteria; the personal statement and commitment through interaction with the institution during the applicant lifecycle.

The scheme is only open for certain courses and students are selected on the criteria outlined above. We will contact applicants on an individual basis to discuss their inclusion and acceptance into the scheme.

The UCAS deadline

Once you've received a decision from all the universities you have applied to, UCAS will tell you the deadline by which you need to respond. You must select a firm (first choice) and insurance (second choice) institution by the stated deadline. Otherwise, UCAS will assume you no longer want your offers and will decline them on your behalf.

All UK schools and colleges (and a small number of establishments overseas) are registered with UCAS to manage students' applications.

If you are currently at school or college, your teacher or a careers adviser will also be able to advise you on the application process. You will need to fill in an online application and submit it to a designated member of staff. After checking your details, and adding the academic reference, your school or college will submit the completed application online to UCAS.

Independent applicants in the UK

If you're not applying through a school or college, there are various careers organisations, such as the National Careers Service that you can consult. You should then submit your completed application online to UCAS, including the correct application fee, and attach your academic references.

International applicants outside the UK (EU and worldwide)

If your school or college is registered with UCAS, they will help you to apply. Otherwise, please use ucas.com to apply independently. Advice should be available from British Council offices as well as your school or college. You'll be responsible for paying the correct application fee and for obtaining and attaching the academic reference.

We recognise, and can offer support on, the wide range of international qualifications and their equivalency. Please email admissions@bucks.ac.uk for advice.


